Born in Vienna (Austria) in 1927, he received his education in Austria, United Kingdom and Israel. He graduated from medical school in Geneva, Switzerland.

Following his post-graduate work in Geneva, he joined the Weizman Institute as senior scientist till 1961, and then headed the WHO International Reference Centre for Fertility Promoting Drugs from 1961 – 1992.

He acted as a consultant and member of Expert Committees at the WHO from 1967 – 1992. From 1967 – 1995 he was Professor of Endocrinology at faculty of Natural Sciences and Mathematics, Dept Of Life Sciences, Bar-Ilan University. From 1975 – 1983 he was President of the Israel Fertility Society, from 1990 – 1995 he was Vice-President and Member of the Executive Board of the Scientific Council, Israel Medical Association. He was a founding member of the Israel Endocrine Society and its President between 1992 and 1995.

Since 1995, he has been Professor Emeritus at the Faculty of Life Sciences, Bar-Ilan University. He was instrumental in the study of the aging male, was the founder of the International Society for the Study of the Aging Male (ISSAM), and its President. He organised, (in collaboration with the WHO), and chaired the first, second and third world Congress of the aging male in Geneva Feb 1998 and 2000, in Berlin in 2002, and Prague 2004.

In 1995 he received the special recognition award of the United States Public Health Service, "in recognition of his outstanding contribution to the promotion of health". In 1995, he received the "Verdienstkreuz 1 Klasse" (Order of Distinction) signed by the President of Germany, Roman Herzog.
